CPT Guidelines indicate your office may bill for the following procedure codes. CPT code verification is recommended prior to billing submission.

INITIAL (NEW PATIENT) EVALUATION

97001	Physical Therapy Evaluation
97003	Occupational Therapy Evaluation
97002	Physical Therapy Re-evaluation
97004	Occupational Therapy Re-evaluation

Frequency: Codes 97001 and 97003 are to be used once per patient to represent an initial assessment. Codes 97002 and 97004 can be used each time a new complete assessment is made. This typically takes place every 4-8 weeks.
